

Where to find health care, prescriptions....

*Most clinics focus on the **uninsured and Medicaid clients**. Some have income limits and/or residency requirements. Call for specific eligibility criteria.*

Primary Care Access Network (PCAN) - Partnership of private groups, Orange County government, hospitals and others. PCAN guides uninsured and Medicaid patients to services. Online: pcanorangecounty.com Phone: 407-836-7226

Central Florida Family Health Center - Private, nonprofit group that runs clinics in Orange and Seminole counties. Dental services are available at some locations. Online: cffhc.org Phone: 407-322-8645

Community Health Centers Inc. - Private, nonprofit group that runs nine clinics in Orange and Lake Counties. Dental services are available at some locations. Online: chcfl.com Phone: 407-905-8827

Health Care Center for the Homeless - Private, nonprofit group that runs a clinic in Orlando and a mobile medical unit that travels into Orange, Osceola and Seminole counties. Services include vision and mental health. Online: hcch.org Phone: 407-428-5751

Shepherd's Hope - Faith-based group that provides care from volunteer doctors at various locations in Orange and Seminole, evening hours. Online: shepherdshope.org Phone: 407-876-6699

Orange County Health Department - Government agency that serves specific groups, such as pregnant women and HIV/AIDS patients. Also provides children's immunizations, dental care and family planning. Online: orchd.com Phone: 407-858-1400

Seminole County Health Department - Offers a range of services that include primary-care for Medicaid clients; HIV and STD treatment; childhood immunizations; maternal-health and pregnancy testing; communicable diseases; children's dental care; and travel vaccines.
